



Made in Whitby Supporters Terms & Conditions

Businesses must be based in YO21/YO22 area which also includes Staithes, Robin Hoods Bay and some of the Esk Valley area.

Products must be of high quality, with a clear provenance and traceability of being made within the Whitby catchment area.

Made in Whitby reserves the right to refuse supporter title to businesses it does not feel have the appropriate collaborative ethos, or where there appears to be a conflict of interest with existing supporters/members.

Supporter title can be revoked at any time if a business does not comply with supporter conditions or is in danger of damaging Made in Whitby's reputation. When the supporter year expires, or when a supporter is revoked, the business will be removed from the website and other promotional activity and the business must also remove the Made in Whitby logo from their promotional activity.

When joining, supporters undertake to not claim to speak on behalf of Made in Whitby, or to make any representation on behalf of Made in Whitby or the Made in Whitby festivals.

Supporters should not allow other items to be advertised under the Made in Whitby heading that are not linked to their own business without prior agreement.

Supporters are encouraged to share and promote the Made in Whitby festivals on social media that will run throughout the year.

Supporter title does not grant a stall at festivals. Stalls will only potentially be available to members of Made in Whitby. The final allocation of stalls will be decided by a small steering group whose decision will be final, however if a stall becomes available and members are unavailable to fill this then a supporter may be asked if they would like to upgrade to a membership status for that particular stall and festival.
